- (1) The above results were reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held at Chennai on February 9, 2017 and subjected to Limited Review by the Statutory Auditors.
- (2) The company operates in a single segment i.e, Fluro-Chemicals in India and all other activities evolve around the same. Hence, there is no reportable primary/ secondary segment.
- (3) Despite the accumulated losses incurred in the past , the financial statements of the company have been prepared on going concern basis having regard to business plans of the company and continued financial support from a promoter.
- (4) The Company has sold its freehold residential vacant land at Cuddalore and profit on sale of said land shown as exceptional item, during the quarter ended 30th June, 2015.
- (5) Renewable Power Obligation (RPO): The company had filed a petition with Hon'ble Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission (TNERC) to declare its 2.3 MW cogeneration plant exempt from RPO obligation. The said petition was dismissed by Hon'ble TNERC on 13<sup>th</sup> November 2015 relying on an order passed by Hon'ble Appellate Tribunal for Electricity (APTEL) in a different petition which the company believes the facts of the case has no applicability to the factors of its petition and also based on erroneous premise that the company's plant is a fossil-fuel based cogeneration plant. Aggrieved by the order the company filed an appeal with Hon'ble APTEL which has been admitted. The company believes, based on the legal advice, that its appeal would be favourably considered by APTEL and accordingly has not made any provision towards RPO from Financial year 2012-13 to 2016-17 Q3 currently estimated at Rs.86.25 lakhs.

#### LIMITED REVIEW REPORT

#### INTRODUCTION

We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of un-audited Financial Results ('FR') of TANFAC INDUSTRIES LIMITED ('the Company') for the Quarter ended December 31, 2016. The un-audited FR initialed by us for identification purpose, is the responsibility of the Company's Management and has been approved by the Board of Directors. Our responsibility is to issue a report on these un-audited FR based on our review.

#### SCOPE OF REVIEW

We conducted our review in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagement ('SRE') 2410, 'Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity' issued by The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This Standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the FR is free of material misstatement. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of Company personnel and an analytical procedure applied to financial data and thus provides less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and, accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

#### CONCLUSION

Based on our review conducted as above, nothing has come to our notice that causes us to believe that the accompanying statement of un-audited FR prepared in accordance with Accounting standards notified under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014 and other recognized accounting practices and policies, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.

### EMPHASIS OF MATTER PARAGRAPH

- In forming our opinion, which is not qualified, we have considered Note no. 3 of the financial results stating that,
  despite losses, the financial results of the company have been prepared under 'Going concern' assumption basis
  having regard to the business plans of the company and continued financial support from a promoter
- II. Attention is invited to Note no. 5 of the financial results, describing company's contention in the matter of Renewable Power Obligation (RPO), which is contested and the company is anticipating a favorable verdict, based on legal advice received by it. Our report is not qualified on the matter
